4. Chord Accompaniment Function (Picture 9)

(1) Single-finger Chord

Press any of the 8, "16 Rhythms" buttons to begin, press the [Single-fingered Chord] button (1), then press any key on the Accompaniment keyboard area (See Picture 10). The electronic keyboard will produce an orchestrated accompaniment. Press once again the [Single-fingered Chord] button and the Single-fingered Chord Accompaniment will stop.

(2) Multi-finger Chord

Press any of the 8, "16 Rhythms" buttons to begin, press the [Multi-fingered Chord] button **3**, now press the keys "C+E+G" or "G+B+D" at the same time on the Accompaniment keyboard area (See Picture 10) and you can make Multi-fingered Chor Accompaniment. Press once again the [Multi-fingered Chord] button and the Multi-fingered Chord Accompaniment will stop.

5. Song Demos (Picture 11)

(1) Demo One

Press this button 🖪 and the electronic keyboard will play one piece of music. Press this button again to skip to the next song. Press the volume adjusting buttons [+] or [-] to adjust the volume during song demo. Press the "STOP" button **G** to switch off the playing.

(2) Demo All

Press this button **2** and the electronic keyboard will play all the music included. Press the volume adjusting buttons [+] or [-] to adjust the volume during song demo. Press the "STOP" button **©** to switch off the playing.

6. Recording/Playback Function (Picture 12)


(1) Press the [REC] button (2), the screen will show the letters "RE". Press any of the Black & White keys to start recording your own songs. When the note is fully recorded, the following keys will all make the same sound and the recording function will be stopped. If you continue pressing the keys then it will simply make pronunciation and won't store it. Press the [PLAY] button **3**, the screen will show the letter "RP", indicating you can playback the songs you have recorded. You can also change the Timbre as well. If you want to repeat listening, press the [PLAY] button 🛭 again.

(2) If you press once again the [REC] button (2), the note you have played won't be stored and a new recording will begin.

7. Play-Along Function (Picture 13)

Press the [PLAY-ALONG] button 🕢 , the screen will show the word "OE". It will play a short melody. At this time you can study the song that is playing according to its melody. Press any combination of keys to play-along to that song. You can skip to the next song by pressing the "Play-Along" button again. Press the "STOP" button to exit Play-Along mode. Altogether there are 40 melodies to choose

Preparation Before Playing. Battery Installation

You can power the unit either by Batteries or by Power Adapter. Follow the instructions described below.

1. Using Batteries



Press the [ON/OFF] button, the screen display will show the number "01", the overall machine will enter into Ready State. Press the Volume Adjustment buttons [+] or [-] to adjust the volume. The default volume level starts at 9. Altogether there are 15 levels available for adjusting.

1. Timbres playing (Picture 2)

Press any of the 8, "16 Timbres" buttons 🙆 to play that musical instruments sounds. (1) You can change the Timbres on the keyboard one by one accordingly by pressing the "Timbres Switch" button 📵. Altogether there are 16 Timbres.

2. Sound Effect Control

(1) Tenuto: (Picture 3)

Begin by pressing the [ON/OFF] button to reset the Keyboard, then press the [TENUTO] button 🙆 Tenuto Function is now active and the screen will show the number "01". The Tenuto effect can be produced immediately in the Electronic Keyboard. Press once again the [TENUTO] button, the Tenuto function will turn

(2)Tremolo: (Picture 3)

Press the [TREMELO] button 🕑 , the Tremolo function is now active and the screen shows the number "01". The Tremolo effect can be produced immediately in the Electronic Keyboard. Press once again the [TREMELO] button, the Tremolo function will turn off.

3. Rhythm Selection (Picture 4)

Press any of the 8 "16 Rhythms" buttons 🗗 to play different Rhythm sounds.


(3) Tempo Speed Adjusting (Picture 7)
